Your Mossman Neighborhood Association (MNA)

The Mossman Neighborhood has many new residents who may not be aware of our Neighborhood Association. The boundaries of the Mossman Neighborhood are Louisiana to San Pedro and from Comanche to the Hahn Arroyo. All residents who live within this boundary are members of the Mossman Neighborhood Association. MNA wants everyone to benefit from knowing their neighbors. We also want all of you to have input on zoning, safety and any other issues that are part of living in Albuquerque.

The Mossman Neighborhood Association is a voluntary organization whose resident members work together to improve and maintain the quality of life we enjoy in our neighborhood. Dues are voluntary contributions. Our neighborhood association has no authority to enforce City or County ordinances or to enact maintenance or design requirements but we know who to contact when there are problems. The City notifies us when there are zoning changes that are within or close to our boundaries so that we can act as necessary. A neighborhood association often has more influence and authority when representing its residents than an individual has. We can help you navigate local government departments.

The Mossman Neighborhood was organized 20 years ago by concerned neighbors in response to a drug house. Since successfully closing the drug house, MNA has combatted a poorly run halfway house, worked with our legislators on the Hahn Arroyo improvements, negotiated with APS the use of the Montgomery School property, worked with the city to landscape the medians on Comanche (twice!), as well as many other zoning and safety issues.
