### Do you know the difference between a Neighborhood Association (NA) and a Home Owners Association (HOA)?

A Neighborhood Association is a group of residents, neighbors, property owners and business owners who work together to effect change and improvements within their neighborhood, such as neighborhood safety, crime prevention, beautification, and social activities.

A Home Owners Association is a legal entity made up of homeowners and property owners with the authority to enforce rules and regulations that focus on housing and building rules, regulations, and safety issues. HOA membership is mandatory and set by rules tied to property ownership in a particular area.

Mossman Neighborhood Association is made up of elected board members and resident members. We have bylaws, hold meetings and vote on actions that affect the neighborhood. Some NAs ask their members to pay dues. Mossman Neighborhood dues are only \$7 per year!

The common element of an NA is that they want to work together to address issues that affect them as a neighborhood. Working together as a group is always more effective, and NAs often work closely with city councilors, city departments, law enforcement, and the Office of Neighborhood Coordination (ONC) to find resources, have questions answered, and connect to other groups within Albuquerque. Being active in your NA not only amplifies your voice, but helps create a community with a shared vision and goal. When neighbors come together and get to know each other, their neighborhood is a safer, more vibrant, and enjoyable place to live.
